Many opportunities existed for the whole family to get involved at the Faribault Community Schools in 2022–23! Extended hours made our programming and activities accessible for families' varied schedules.



### Recognition

With the Community Schools' funding scheduled to end in August 2023, Faribault Public Schools and Healthy Community Initiative (HCI) were recently awarded a new, highly competitive 21st Century **Community Learning Center** grant from the Minnesota Department of Education. This will allow for the continuation of the Community Schools at Jefferson Elementary and Faribault Middle School, as well as the addition of Community Schools at Roosevelt Elementary, Lincoln Elementary, and Faribault High School, starting in 2023-24.
